Celebrate Earth Day by taking a leisurely hike through the forty acre Drexel Woods. During this month of April, the beauty of our Mother Earth is emerging after the long months of winter. The forest floor will be alive with spring wildflowers such as spring beauty, trout lily and May apple. Some of our amphibians such as red-backed salamanders or green frogs may be out. The forest begins to produce the sounds of some of our early resident nesting birds such as the wood thrush, eastern towhee and common yellowthroat. Join the naturalist from the *Friends of the Lawrence Nature Center* for this walk along 1 ¼ miles of trails and boardwalks in Drexel Woods.

This program will be from 10:00 a.m. to approximately 11:30 a.m. Children must be accompanied by an adult. Dress appropriately for the weather conditions; boots are highly recommended. The trails are relatively flat and easy to traverse but could be wet and muddy at this time of the year.
